Price does not include airfare and connecting travel to Le Creusot TGV or Beaune. Le Creusot TGV and Beaune are each a 30 minute ride from Domaine de Cromey. Transit will be provided from the TGV station or Beaune to Cromey, but arrival times must be sent in advance to coordinate pick-up.

The hosts will have limited seating in a rental vehicle and can provide connection from Paris to Cromey on Sunday morning for an additional €50pp on a first come, first served basis. The trip will terminate in Lyon on Friday evening and all travel after that point is the responsibility of the guest.

### CONDITIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Guaranteed departure is based on 10 attendees. Due to the unpredictable nature of harvest and that Burgundy is an active agriculturally driven region, the schedule and itinerary is subject to change. All attempts will be made to inform guests of major changes in itinerary, but hosts will work to preserve the integrity of the experience and the economy of the region.

Cancellations made after the second installment has been paid, but at least two months in advance of departure will incur a €1,000 cancellation fee in addition to the non-refundable deposit. Cancellations made less than two months prior to departure are subject to complete forfeiture of all payments, unless the reservation can be filled, in which case there will be a €2,000 cancellation fee in addition to the deposit.
